
Jolla Phone brings European mobile technology back to the smartphone market with 10,000 pre-orders

World premiere of the new Jolla Phone takes place in MWC26 Barcelona, Spain

In just three months, the Finnish technology company Jolla achieved a milestone that European tech rarely sees: 10,000 pre-orders for a smartphone built entirely on a European operating system, representing over €5 million in committed sales. Launched in December 2025, the Jolla Phone is Europe's only smartphone built on its own operating system, and with production now confirmed for Q2/2026, final assembly will take place in Salo, Finland — the historic home of Nokia's factories. In the same city where Nokia once built the world's most popular phones, a new European phone is now being born.



“The most valuable part of a modern smartphone is its software and how it is made. As Jolla compiles the operating system from source code by itself, it is also essential to ensure its integrity by installing the software by ourselves in Finland. This is not just a phone – it’s a statement that Europe can still build its own technology, on its own terms.” – Sami Pienimäki, CEO, Jolla.



The Jolla Phone is Europe's only independent smartphone, thanks to Linux based Sailfish OS. Only four commercial-grade mobile operating systems remain in the world: Apple's iOS and Google's Android from the United States, Huawei's HarmonyOS from China – and Jolla's European Sailfish OS. Thanks to Sailfish OS, the Jolla Phone offers Europeans an alternative that doesn't send user data to Big Tech servers.

"10,000 Europeans chose a phone built on European values. That tells us something important: people want technology that respects them. We don't need to copy Silicon Valley or Shenzhen to build great products — we need to build products that are genuinely ours. That's what Jolla is doing, and we're just getting started." – Antti Saarnio, Chairman of the Board, Jolla.

Privacy Built In

The Jolla Phone runs on Sailfish OS, a European operating system based on Linux. Unlike mainstream smartphones, Sailfish OS sends no background data, contains no hidden analytics, and doesn't require a Google account. The phone also features a physical privacy switch that allows users to disable the microphone, camera, and other sensors at will.



Users can still run Android apps through Jolla's AppSupport technology. Banking apps, messaging services, and everyday applications work normally – without Big Tech surveillance.

New Batch Now Open for Pre-Order

Following the close of the pre-order campaign on February 28, 2026 — with 10,000 units and over €5 million in committed sales secured — Jolla is now opening a new limited batch of 1,000 units for pre-order at €649 with delivery in September 2026. Pre-order customers pay a €99 deposit, which is deducted from the final price.

The phone is available in EU countries, the UK, Norway, and Switzerland, with the first shipments starting in end of June 2026.

Jolla's goal is to build a permanent mobile platform in Europe that combines privacy, openness, and technological sovereignty. The company plans to expand its product range and develop the Sailfish OS ecosystem in collaboration with European partners.

Jolla is a Finnish technology company founded in 2011 by former Nokia engineers building on the MeeGo operating system. The company has developed the Sailfish OS operating system for over a decade, offering a European alternative to the market dominated by Big Tech giants. Jolla launched its first smartphone in 2013.
